- The nominee's Curriculum Vitae and no more than 3 letters of recommendation may be included.
- This award will be presented at the discretion of the judges, based on the submissions received.
- This category is awarded in Queensland only.
- This award will not necessarily be recognised annually. The judges will take into account the following aspects of the contribution when assessing a nomination.
