



## **Sarina & Coal Driving Itinerary**

### **Mackay – Sarina – Hay Point Lookout**

Time to complete itinerary: 1 day

Distance travelled: Approximately 95km round trip

Total walking time: Approximately 2 hours

#### **Start in Mackay**

- Sarina is about 35km south of Mackay by road.
- From Mackay, travel south on the Bruce Highway for 30km until you reach the township of Sarina.
- If you have time, visit the beaches off the coast of Sarina including Grasstree, Campwin and Sarina Beach. You just need to make a left-hand turn down Sarina Beach Road as you approach the township and follow the signs.

#### **Sarina Sugar Shed**

- Located at the south end of Sarina, on the right hand side of the highway (if travelling from the north). It's the only miniature working mill and distillery in Australia! The Sarina Sugar Shed offers close-up, interactive and highly engaging tours, and you get to taste some yummy goodies as well!
- Tours take around one hour and includes a movie in the theatre, a tour of the cane plantation and outdoor display area, and the miniature mill in action.
- Kids will love the fairy floss and adults can taste nips of liqueur, schnapps, vodka or ginger beer.
- Tours run four times per day at 9.30am, 11am, 12.30pm and 2pm.
- The Sarina Sugar Shed is open every day from 9am to 4pm except on public holidays.

#### **Port of Hay Point Lookout**

- The Port of Hay Point is one of the biggest coal ports in the world. The Port Admin building features a public viewing gallery and fantastic views of Dalrymple Bay Coal Terminal and the Hay Point Services Coal Terminal.
- From Mackay, travel approximately 20km south towards Sarina and turn left at Alligator Creek, at the signs for Hay Point Road. If you are travelling from Sarina, head north on the Bruce Highway towards Mackay and turn right down Hay Point Road.
- Follow Hay Point Road for 2km and turn left to continue for another 8km where you will need to turn left again at the signs for the Hay Point Terminal Lookout.
